### Study Background & Purpose

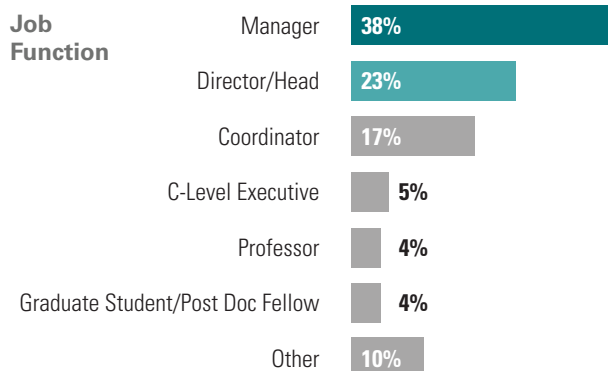
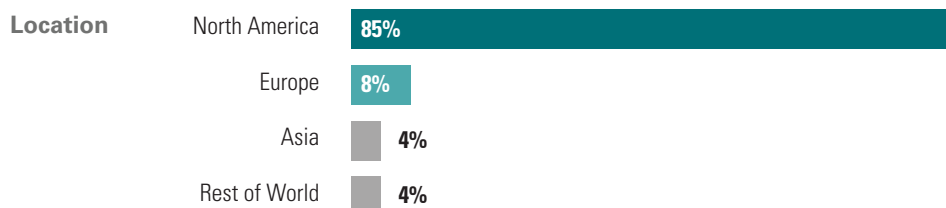
In October 2013, Clinical Informatics News conducted a survey within the biotechnology and pharmaceutical sector on Clinical Project Management. The purpose of the study was to determine how clinical project managers see the globalization of clinical trials, what challenges they face, what tools they believe will help them, as well as their budget predictions for 2014.

With 356 respondents the study is projected to carry a margin-of-error under 2%.

Participants were from the following countries and reported the following job functions



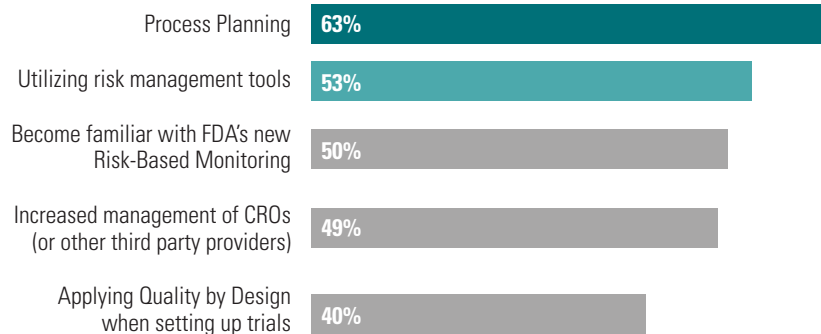
All bar charts share a common baseline and a maximum percentage of 100%

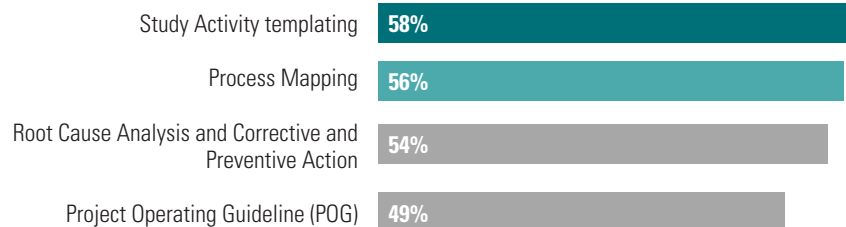
How has the globalization of clinical trials impacted the role of the clinical project manager?



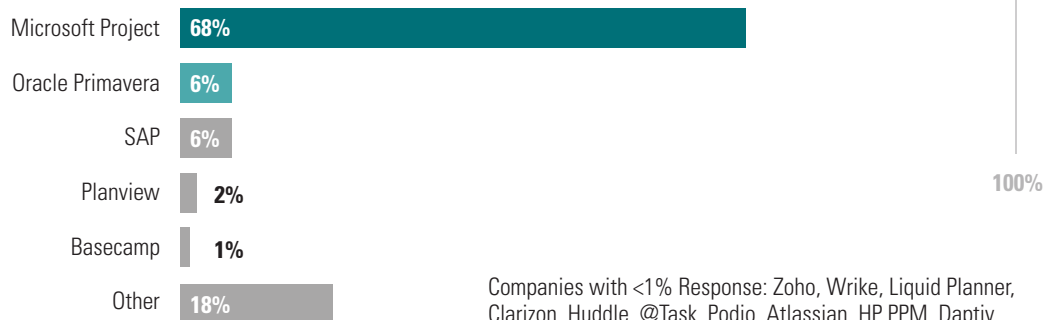
What risk-avoidance based approaches have you implemented in your project management role?



Are there particular tools that would help you perform your project management job better?



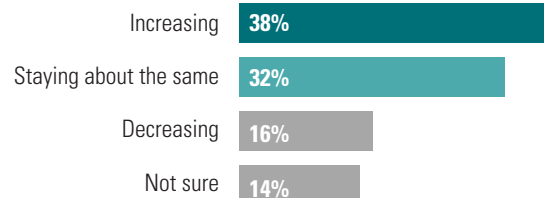
What Project Management software do you use for your project planning?



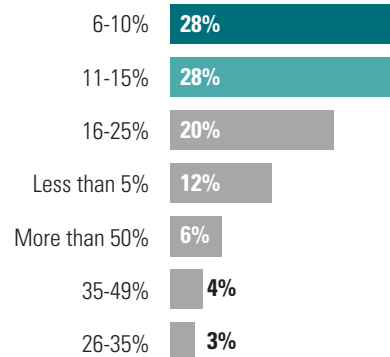
What are the greatest challenges faced by project managers in the coming 3-5 years?

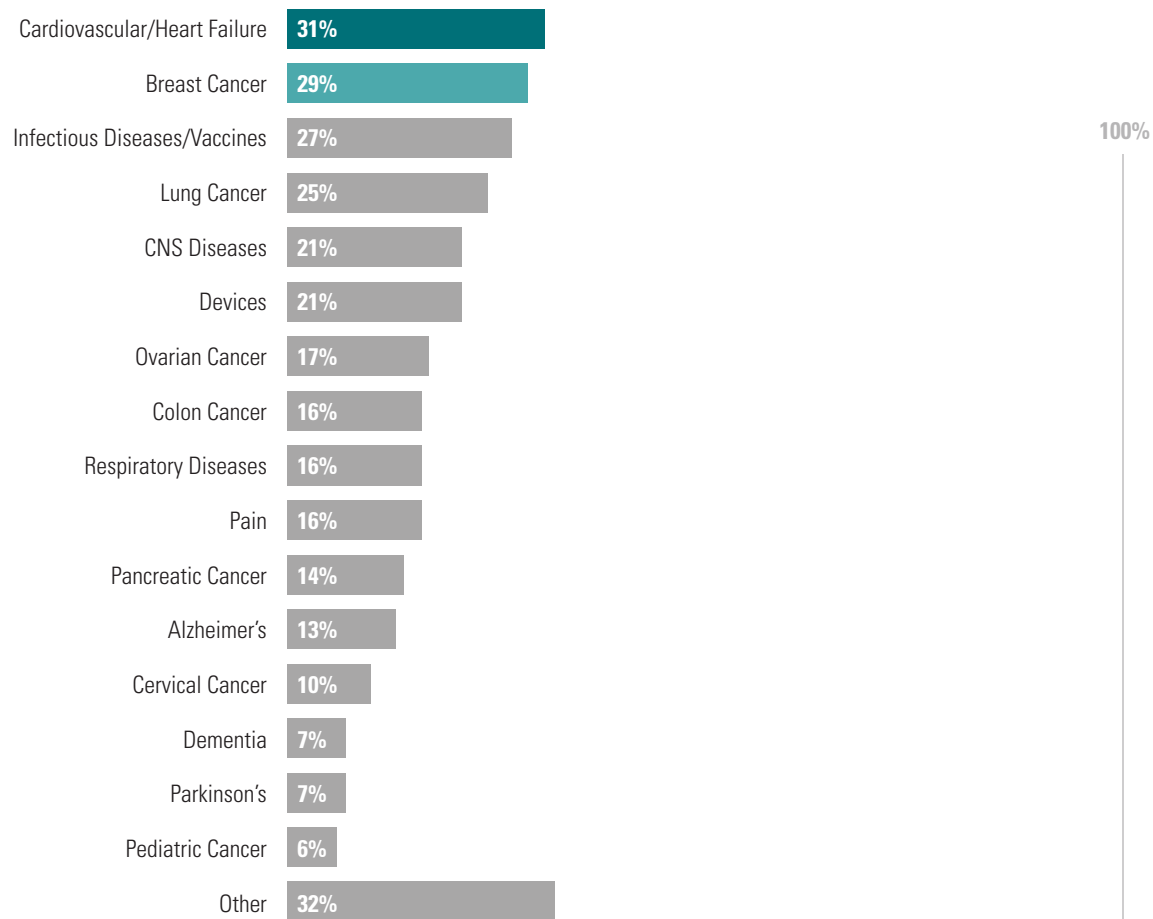
If increasing, how much do you expect your budget to increase?

## In which research areas are your clinical trials?



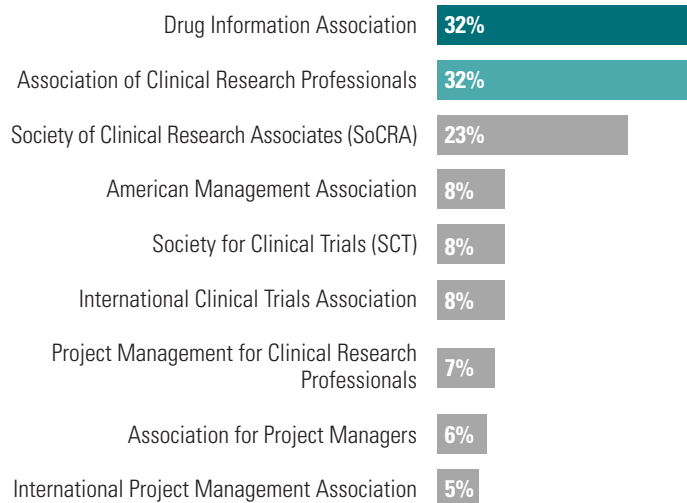
